Residential Listing Agreements

What this form is for

Designed for listings for the lease of 1-4 family residential dwellings including condos, townhomes, and patio homes. Appropriate addenda may be attached.

Key sections and how to complete the form

Use the form in order. The sections below explain the main decisions, blanks, disclosures, or deadlines the form is designed to address. Complete the actual form from the transaction facts and the instructions printed on the current version.

Parties and property

Identify the landlord/tenant or other parties and the exact property or space covered by the lease or addendum.

Term and money

Complete the applicable dates, rent, deposits, fees, or other monetary obligations stated in the form.

Rights, restrictions, and responsibilities

Review the sections allocating use, maintenance, access, default, insurance, or other responsibilities.

Notices and signatures

Complete notice information and obtain required signatures/dates. Keep the executed form with the underlying lease.

Related forms and resources

These documents may connect to this form depending on the property, financing, occupancy, disclosure requirements, or other facts of the transaction. Open the related resource to see what it does and how it is completed.

Condominium Addendum to Listing

TXR 1401

Review when: Use the condominium addendum when the property being listed for lease is a condominium.

Keybox Authorization by Tenant

TXR 1411

Review when: Use when the property is tenant occupied and a keybox will be placed with tenant authorization.

Amendment to Lease Listing

TXR 1423

Review when: Use to amend the Residential Real Estate Listing Agreement Exclusive Right to Lease.

Protect Your Family from Lead in Your Home Pamphlet

TXR 2511

Review when: Provide the EPA lead pamphlet when the dwelling was built before 1978 and federal lease-disclosure rules apply.
